+ Is a community owned and directed platform.





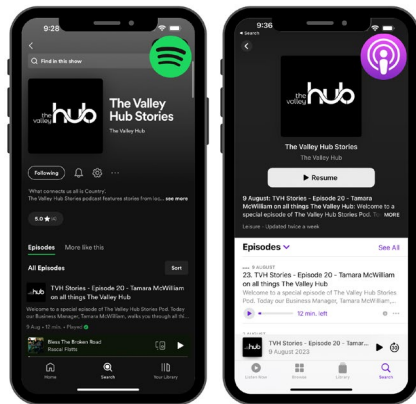
